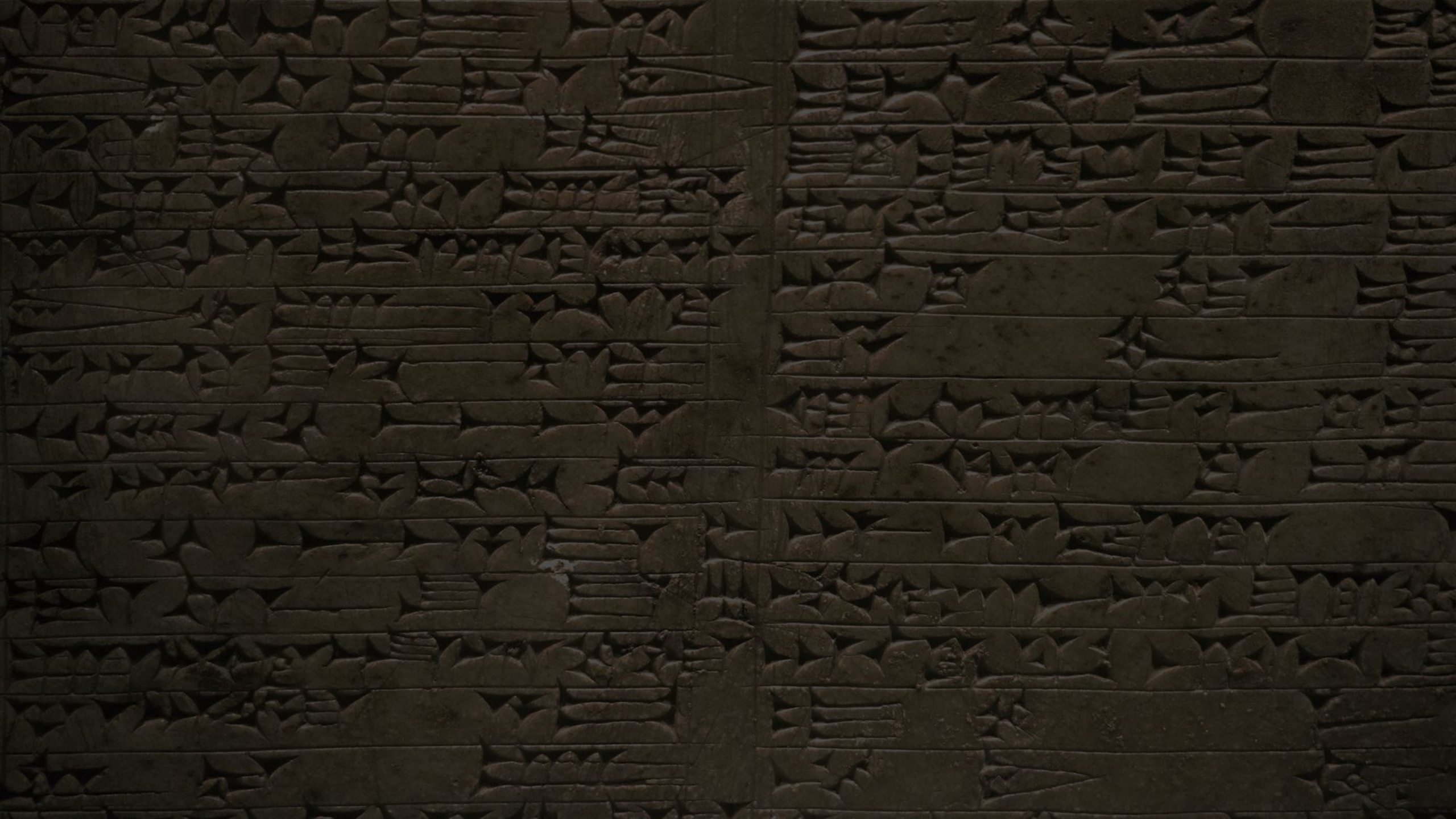


**Seventy weeks = 490 years**
