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<sup>11</sup> For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren, by Chloe's *people*, that there are quarrels among you.

<sup>12</sup> Now I mean this, that each one of you is saying, "I am of Paul," and "I of Apollos," and "I of Cephas," and "I of Christ." <sup>13</sup>

Has Christ been divided? Paul was not crucified for you, was he? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?

- *No man can fully represent Christ and His gifts*
- Paul was not crucified for you was he?
- *No man can take Christ's place in the salvation process*
- Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- *No man sets you apart but Jesus*



**Many Individuals No Divisions**

<sup>14</sup> I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, <sup>15</sup> so that no one would say you were baptized in my name. <sup>16</sup> Now I did baptize also the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I do not know whether I baptized any other.
