

Our responsibility and God's Enabling Provision

- You shall consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy, for I am the LORD your God. You shall keep My statutes and practice them; I am the LORD who sanctifies you. (20:7-8)
- You are therefore to make a distinction between the clean ... and the unclean (20:25)
- ... you are to be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy; I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine. (20:26)
